Uniforms

The choir owns and manages the uniforms used by the choir levels from Dolcine all the way up to Prime Voci. In addition to maintaining the current inventory we arrange to have new uniforms made and traveling outfits coordinated for those girls touring. When your daughter joins the choir we will ask for a refundable Uniform Deposit prior to her being issued a dress. As she moves up through the various choir levels that deposit amount will increase in proportion to the changes and additions to her uniform.

One or more "Uniform Parent" is assigned at each choir level to assist in sizing the girls each season, issuing uniforms, maintaining accurate records about which uniforms have been issued to which girl, collect uniform deposits for the treasurer, and arrive at call time for each performance to check uniform compliance and assist in any emergency repairs. The Uniform Parent also monitors the return of uniforms at the end of a concert or season (choir specific) and the return of uniforms from girls who have withdrawn from the choir. Once the uniform has been received from a girl withdrawing, the treasurer is notified and the deposit refunded.

This is a very important volunteer roll in this organization and we so value your participation! You can also help your daughter be a success by making sure her uniform is neat and clean and hemmed to the appropriate length prior to any performance. With the girls looking perfectly matched on stage the audience can then focus solely on the lovely music they are performing for us.
